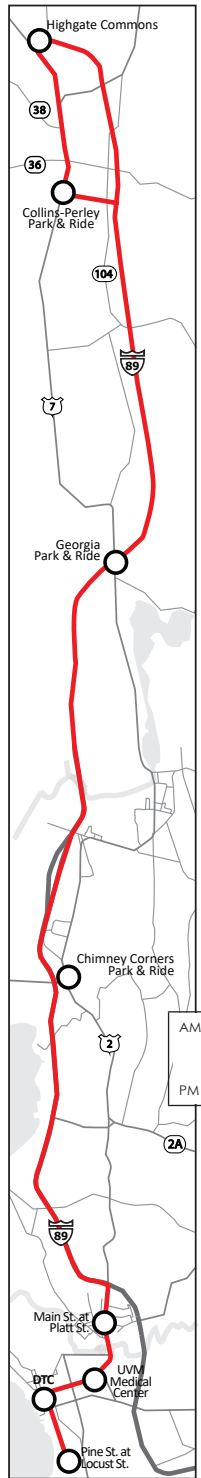


 All GMT buses are equipped with wheelchair lifts/ramps and two or more spaces to accommodate wheelchairs up to the weight capacity of the lift/ramp.

2. Give LINK driver transfer ticket when boarding LINK bus
3. Pay fare difference to equal LINK fare

Holidays: There is no regular bus service and the GMT administrative office is closed on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day. GMT may operate a modified schedule on Christmas Eve, please call 802-527-2181 for more information.

Lost and Found: Items lost on the bus may be picked up the next day after 10:00 AM at the GMT Administrative Offices. Call 802-527-2181 to be sure your item(s) have been found — items are kept for 30 days. GMT is not responsible for items left on buses.

Discounted fare available to those age 6 to 17, seniors age 60 and over, persons with disabilities and those with Medicare cards. A driver's license or non-driver's identification card issued by the Vermont DMV may be required to prove eligibility of age.

One child, age five and under, rides free when accompanied by a fare paying adult passenger. Additional children receive discount fare rate. Does not include LINK Express or Local Commuter routes. Exact fare required; drivers cannot make change.

Local Commuter fare is available on the Milton Commuter, Jeffersonville Commuter, and 116 Commuter as well as travel on **LINK Express routes within the same county.**

Children are responsible for paying the full fare on all LINK Express and Local Commuter routes. Only children under the age of two who will be sitting on an adult's lap are not required to pay.

ADA and Special Services
Boarding and Medical Equipment: Passengers with disabilities are afforded the time they need to board and disembark the bus. Passengers with respirators, concentrators or portable oxygen may bring these items on the bus.

Elderly and Disabled Service: GMT in collaboration with C.I.D.E.R., provide transportation services for meal sites, shopping, non-Medicaid medical appointments, critical care and basic transit needs. These services are made possible through the State of Vermont Elderly and Disabled grant. Champlain Valley Agency on Aging also provides a limited number of free St. Albans Downtown Shuttle passes for passengers who qualify on a first-come, first-served basis.

Medicaid Transportation: As a Medicaid transportation provider with the State of Vermont, GMT provides and coordinates transportation services to eligible Vermonters for medically necessary and approved trips.

Cancellation / No-Shows: Customers may incur penalties for repeated cancellations / no-shows for requested route deviations or stops. For a Failure to Board Policy visit [RideGMT.com](https://ridegmt.com).

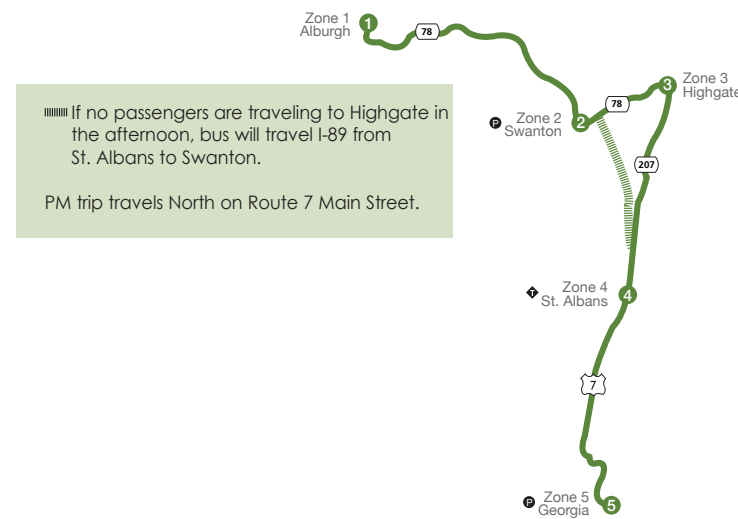

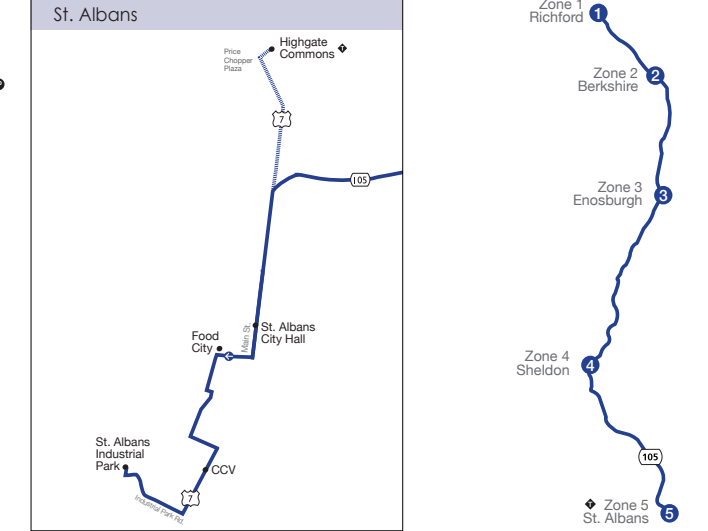
