65 Feedback on Draft Work Plan

- Commissioner Polyte: Concerned that some GMT employees may lack access to a
- 67 smartphone on which to reply to the survey that Talitha intended to release to 68 employees.
- Nate Bergeron: Suggested administering paper surveys to non-admin individuals, which
 would be distributed to their mailboxes.
- Karimah Edwards: Talitha has found that mobile-based surveys tend to be more
 equitable, but Talitha may be able to do paper surveys as well.
- Farhan Ahmed: Why does the current Talitha timeline suggest a December wrap-up,
 when the contract is for one year? Mark Hughes: Will check with Charis Hnin and follow
 up with an answer.
 - Jon Moore: Does not see issue with Talitha's work extending beyond December 15.
