State Grant Application

GM Clark outlined the plan to address the cost-saving measures needed for the application, which included changes to MyRide service and potential reductions in seasonal service.

GM Clark answered questions related to sentiments towards the reduction in seasonal services, increased contributions vs. reduction in service, the costs of service, and the timeline of these conversations.

Legislative Update

GM Clark provided an update on his dealings with the legislature, including meeting with Chittenden County Legislators last week and hoping to meet with the Senate Transportation Committee.

GM Clark added that the Necrason group has been immensely helpful in keeping GMT attuned to what is happening at the state house.

Strategic Planning Planning

GM Clark explained the staff's desire to partner with the Leadership Committee to develop the next strategic plan and outlined a plan to create a strategic planning group that would present an update at the June meeting.

The Committee discussed the structure and make-up of the working group and the potential of bypassing the committee structure.

Central Vermont Service Director

GM Clark noted that the current Director of Central Vermont Services has given her notice, expressed concerns around recruiting, and plans to support Washington County.
