

MyRide by GMT Microtransit Pilot: Proposed Service Adjustments

Green Mountain Transit (GMT) is evaluating service adjustments to the **MyRide by GMT** microtransit pilot in response to the conclusion of **Mobility & Transportation Innovation (MTI) grant funding** from the Vermont Agency of Transportation (VTrans). This funding has been critical in supporting the pilot program, and its expiration necessitates adjustments to the service area of Montpelier and into Berlin.

As we assess potential changes, our goal remains to balance **service efficiency** with the **transportation needs of our riders**. We recognize the impact these adjustments may have on the community and encourage public input on the next iteration of public transit for this service area.

Proposed Service Adjustment Scenarios

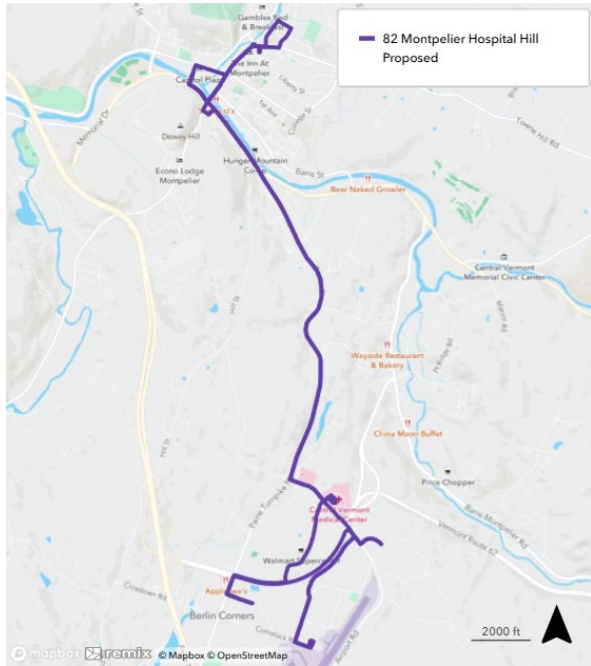
GMT has developed two potential service scenarios. Each scenario considers factors such as **geographic coverage, service hours, and trip availability**. We encourage riders and stakeholders to review these options and share their thoughts through the channels identified below. Each of these scenarios would include a return of the Montpelier Hospital Hill (MHH) run which existed prior to the MyRide microtransit pilot.

Revised Montpelier Hospital Hill

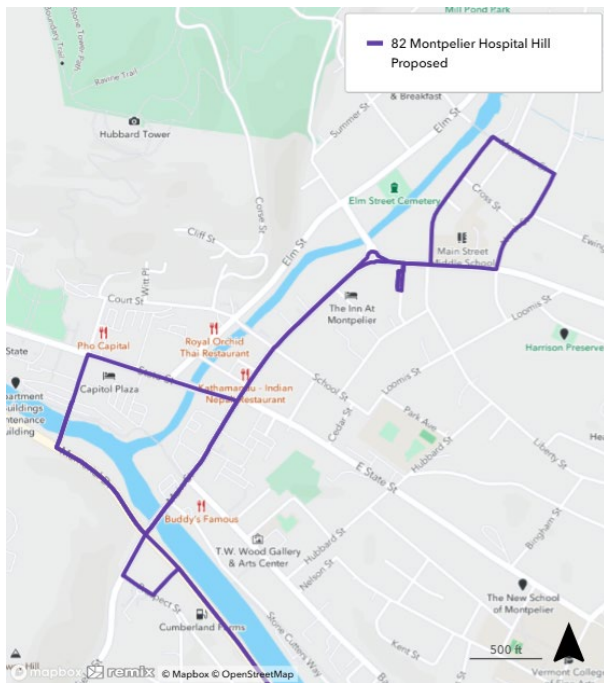
Both scenarios include a revised Montpelier Hospital Hill. A draft timetable and more detailed routing can be found below. This route would also have a deviation zone of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile around the route. Please note that the exact timetable and routing is still subject to change pending public feedback, GMT Board approval, and internal processes.

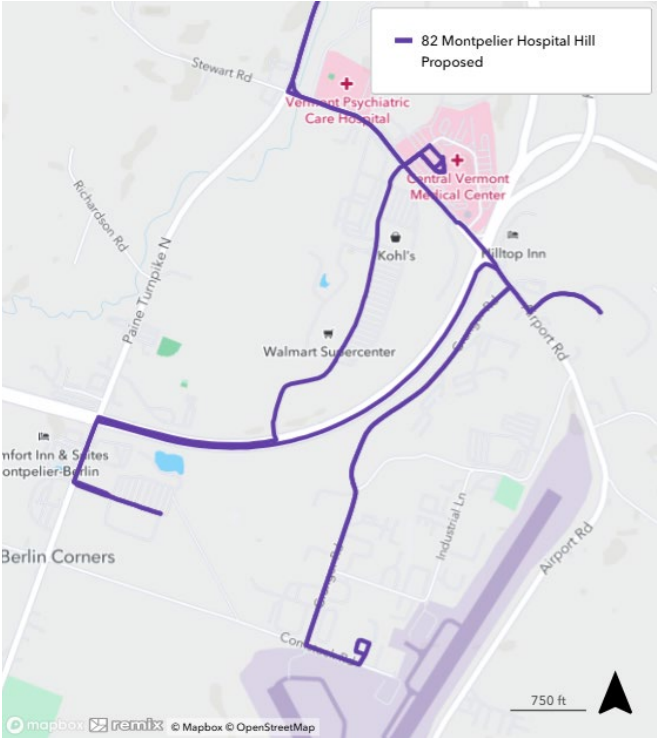
Overview of MHH Route



Downtown Montpelier

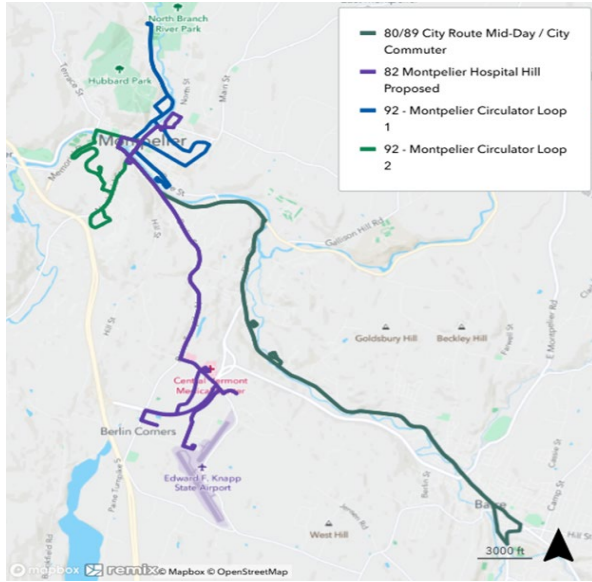


Hospital Hill Area

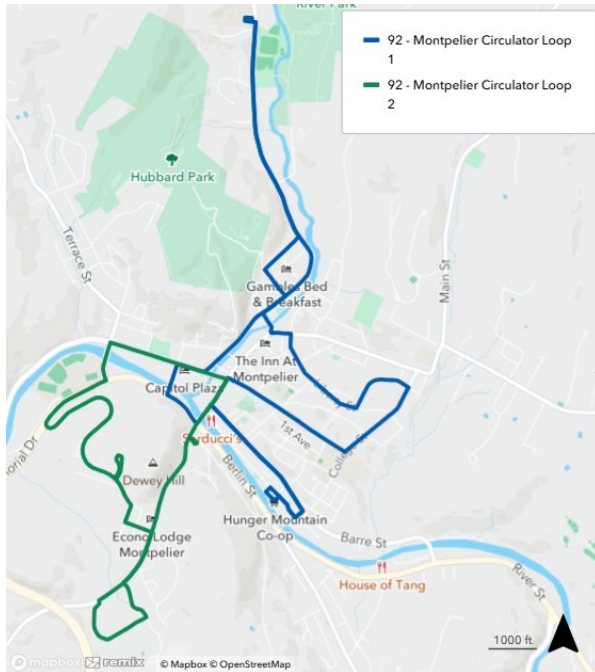


Scenario 1: Return of revised Montpelier Hospital Hill (MHH) and Montpelier Circulator

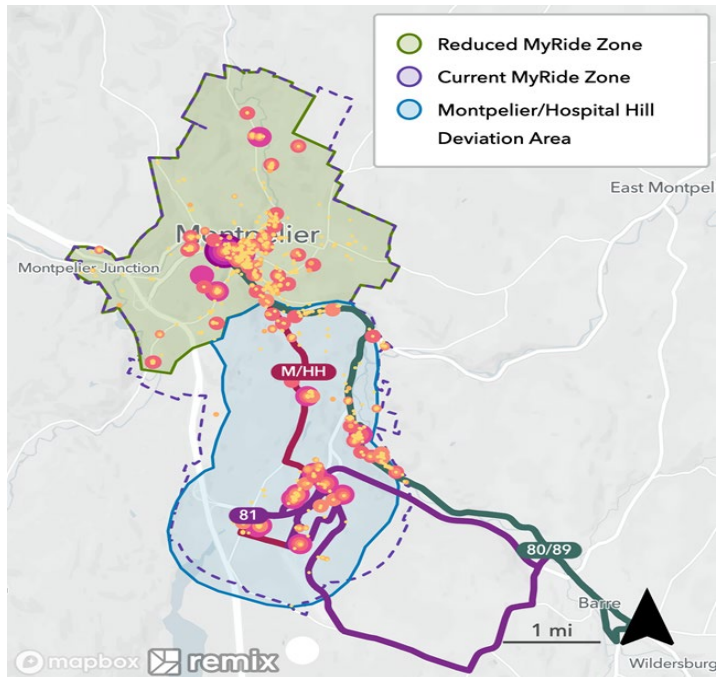

This scenario includes a return of the Montpelier Hospital Hill with a revised routing as well as a return of the Montpelier Circulator. Both of these routes would also have a deviation zone of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile around each route. There would be no change to the current City Commuter routing. Trips outside of the $\frac{3}{4}$ mile deviation zone that are eligible for the Older Adults and Persons with Disabilities program or Non-Emergency Medical Transportation would be serviced under those programs.

Montpelier Hospital Hill: Monday-Saturday 7:25am-6:23pm.

Montpelier Circulator: Monday-Friday 6:50am-5:46pm.

Scenario 2: Return of revised Montpelier Hospital Hill (MHH) and reduced MyRide zone



This scenario includes a return of the Montpelier Hospital Hill with a revised routing as well as continuation of the MyRide by GMT service with a smaller service area focused on the downtown core of Montpelier and certain areas in Berlin such as the Amtrak station and GMT office. As is currently the case in the current and proposed MyRide zone, any rides that are within the MyRide service area that are eligible for the Older Adults and Persons with Disabilities program or Non-Emergency Medical Transportation would be serviced by the MyRide service.

Montpelier Hospital Hill: Monday-Saturday 7:25am-6:23pm.

MyRide Service: Monday-Friday 7:00am-6:00pm. (Vehicle Hours: 2 vehicles during peak and 1 midday)
